They will also visit the campuses of School of Business and School of Law & Social Sciences.	<u>One-way</u> transportation from Millennia Institute to SMU will be provided. Students will be dismissed from SMU.
15 May 1450h – 1650h	Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS) (463 Clementi Rd, Singapore 599494)	Participants will learn about university life at SUSS through a campus tour and sharing on the full-time undergraduate programmes that the university offers. Mock interview sessions will be conducted to simulate the university application interview process to allow students to be better prepared for future applications.	<u>One-way</u> transportation from Millennia Institute to SUSS will be provided. Students will be dismissed from SUSS.
